CHANGES TO DIRECT SERVICES BETWEEN MILTON KEYNES, BLETCHLEY, LEIGHTON BUZZARD, TRING, BERKHAMSTED, HEMEL HEMPSTEAD and WEST and SOUTH LONDON via the West London Line

From Spring 2009, timetable changes improve Monday-Friday peak journeys on the regular direct Southern West London Line services between Milton Keynes Central and stations north of Watford Junction and

SHEPHERD'S BUSH for Westfield London Shopping Centre

KENSINGTON OLYMPIA

WEST BROMPTON for Earl's Court

CLAPHAM JUNCTION

South London stations (see below) and EAST CROYDON

These trains allow you to reach the heart of West London and to cross London without the hassle and extra cost of Zone 1 travel via Euston and Victoria or the challenges of the M25.

The 0701 Monday-Friday train from Milton Keynes Central now arrives earlier at all stations between Shepherd's Bush and Clapham Junction inclusive. From Monday 18 May 2009, all Southern trains to or from Milton Keynes Central will serve Bletchley.

Journey times include:-

Milton Keynes Central to Shepherd's Bush - 63 min
Leighton Buzzard to West Brompton - 57 min
Berkhamsted to Clapham Junction - 51 min
Hemel Hempstead to Balham - 58 min

South London stations served by these trains are Wandsworth Common, Balham, Streatham Common, Norbury, Thornton Heath and Selhurst.

ONWARD CONNECTIONS

These new services provide good interchange with London Underground's CENTRAL LINE at Shepherd's Bush, the DISTRICT LINE at West Brompton and the NORTHERN LINE at Balham.

Change at Clapham Junction or East Croydon for GATWICK AIRPORT, Brighton and the Sussex Coast.

Change at Clapham Junction for Richmond, Woking, Guildford, Basingstoke, Portsmouth, Southampton, Bournemouth, Salisbury and the South West.

Change at Balham for same-platform connections to Crystal Palace, Norwood Junction, West Croydon, Mitcham, Sutton, Epsom, Leatherhead and Dorking.
