## WLLG Response to Withdrawal of Monday-Friday GTR/Southern West London Line Trains

### Progress Report 2 - 11 July 2016

To All West London Line Users

Following our request to London Overground and their agreement to assist covering the gaps on the West London Line due to the withdrawal of the Southern WLL service, the Group is pleased to report that London Overground ran the following extra trains to-day (Monday) and that they seek to do so for the rest of the week.

The extra trains are to run in service between Clapham Junction and Shepherd's Bush northbound in the morning peak and southbound in the evening peak and these are shown in heavy type below among the regular London Overground services. Some of the four extras run in the Southern 'paths'; none of the other Southern WLL departures will be covered. **Give yourself enough time to check and reach departure platforms each day.**
